The [KSDS Jazz 88.3](#) Allstars is a jazz quintet performing classics and standards from the Great American Songbook, putting together high-energy sets of great jazz compositions from the greats, such as Wayne Shorter, Horace Silver, Joe Henderson, Miles Davis, and many more. Their lineup consists of some of Southern California's most respected and sought-after soloists and session musicians who perform and record with a variety of groups.

The rhythm section is highlighted by respected piano man **Mikan Zlatkovich**, with the versatile **Bill Andrews**, a longtime veteran of San Diego's music scene and sought-after sideman, on bass, and **Barry Farrar**, who has hosted the "Percussive Profiles" show on KSDS JAZZ 88.3 for more than 30 years, on drums.

The front line horn section features **Steve Ebner**, a Berklee School of Music graduate, on trumpet. Steve performs regularly in a variety of musical settings, both live and in studio. Accomplished saxophone player **Bob Campbell** can be heard performing with many different groups, including ESP.

The group regularly performs at The Jazz 88 Ocean Beach Jazz festival (every year since its inception) and the Temecula Jazz Festival, and recently at the Mingei Museum Special Art Show presentations and UCSD's ArtPower (November 2011).
